NOTICE TO BIDDERS
FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF
REHABILITATION AND CRACK SEAL OF TAXIWAY F
AT THE
AKRON - CANTON AIRPORT
North Canton, Ohio

Sealed proposals for the construction of Rehabilitation and Crack Seal of Taxiway F Contract will be received at the Akron - Canton Airport Terminal until April 6, 2021, 10:00am, local time. The bids will be received and publicly opened and read aloud at that date and time. Bids can be dropped off at the Akron-Canton Airport's 2nd Floor Board Room. **Bids received after April 6, 2021, 10:00am will not be accepted.**

The proposed project generally includes pavement rehabilitation and crack sealing of select portions of Taxiway F. This work shall include the following:

- Rehabilitation of 3,750' x 75' of Taxiway F between Taxiway F1 and Taxiway A. The rehabilitation of this portion will be completed through resurfacing the wearing course of the pavement.
- Rehabilitation of a section Taxiway F between Runway 5 and approximately 200' north of Taxiway F1, plus Taxiway apron AP4. This area will require pavement crack sealing.
- Adjusting the safety area grades as necessary in order to meet grading standards. This work will also require adjustments to the existing lighting system, adjusting accordingly to meet the required grades.

An electronic file of the Contract Documents (consisting of the Advertisement, the Proposal, the Contract Form, and the Specifications) and the Contract Drawings may be obtained only from **Microsoft Onedrive**. A hyperlink to the files can be obtained by contacting Sharon Millhouse of C&S Engineers, Inc. at smillhouse@cscos.com where the Contractor's name, contact name, address, telephone number, and email address will be recorded on the plan holders list. Submitted proposals that were not recorded on the plan holders list shall be considered non-responsive.

After award, the low bidder shall be prepared to hold bid prices for anticipated start of construction expected as late as September 2021, weather dependent. This Contract does not allow for price escalation in unit bid items.

Each proposal must be accompanied by a certified check or bid bond, in the amount of five percent (5%) of the total maximum proposal price (combination of base bid or alternate bid plus add-on items) for the contract in the form and subject to the conditions provided in the Preparation of Proposal.

Every request concerning this project must be emailed to Sharon Millhouse. To be given consideration, questions must be received at least seven (7) days prior to the date fixed for opening of bids (close of business March 30, 2021). Any supplemental instructions will be in the form of written addenda, which,

when issued, will be sent and or posted not later than twenty-four (24) hours prior to the date fixed for the opening of bids. All addenda so issued shall become part of the Contract and acknowledged by Bidder.

A mandatory pre-bid conference has been scheduled for March 16, 2021 at 2:00pm at the Akron - Canton Airport Terminal, second floor conference room. Masks are required and social distancing will be practiced. A site visit will be accommodated with one person per company following the meeting.

The Owner reserves the right to waive any informality in the proposal, and to reject any and all proposals.
